THE MAUI FOOD BANK (MFB) COORDINATES SERVICE DELIVERY OF DONATED FOOD TO NEEDY INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES THROUGH A NETWORK OF OVER 100 AGENCIES THAT ARE MEMBERS OF THE FOOD BANK IN MAUI COUNTY INCLUDING AGENCIES ON THE ISLANDS OF LANAI AND MOLOKAI.
